### **D&L Trail Alliance: Valley Council Meeting to be Held in Northampton**

**EASTON (May 2)** – The Delaware & Lehigh National Heritage Corridor (D&L) will hold a D&L Trail Alliance: Lehigh Valley Regional Trail Council public meeting on May 9, 2017 from 4:30 pm – 6:30 pm, at the Northampton Borough Hall, 1401 Laubach Avenue, Northampton, PA 18067. The D&L Lehigh Valley Region includes Lehigh and Northampton counties. This is a biannual meeting where municipal officials, trail managers, trail enthusiasts, business owners and anyone else with an interest in the trails of the Lehigh Valley can meet to learn and share ideas. The meeting is open to the public.
