#### D&L Trail Towns Dashboard and Self-Assessment Instructions

### Purpose of the dashboard and self-assessments.

The goals of the surveys are:

- 1) To collect participant's ideas, opinions, and knowledge in an organized way.
- 2) They are an exercise that forces participants to look objectively at the current resources available to trail users.
- 3) Provides qualitative and quantitative data to track change over time.

#### How we use this data.

The local steering committee will use all of the data to create a work plan based on priorities, improvements, and ideas suggested by the participants. This data will serve as a baseline that will help us track improvements as we implement projects over time.

#### **General Instructions**

There are different surveys.

- 1) D&L Trail Town Dashboard Metrics Required
- 2) Topic Specific Self-Assessments
  - a. First Impressions
  - b. Historic Preservation
  - c. Trail Businesses List
  - d. Shops & Amenities
  - e. Trailhead Amenities
  - f. Town Public Amenities

The D&L Trail Town Dashboard Metrics is required for each participant to complete. This is the bare minimum that we need from each participant. The D&L Trail Town Dashboard Metrics is focused on a specific trailhead. If you survey different trailheads, then you need to complete a different D&L Trail Town Dashboard Metrics survey for each trailhead. The Topic Specific Self-Assessments are more detailed surveys that drill down on a specific topic. We encourage participants or groups to choose a topic that they are interested in and complete it.

Groups can work together and discuss things, but everyone should fill out their own form. Different people will have different views and opinions. We want to capture everyone's' ideas.

If you do not know the answer write that or mark "Unsure". That is another data point! If you leave a question blank we do not know if you skipped it or didn't want to answer.
