## MESSAGE FROM LEADERSHIP

To Our Community,

We often hear that “time flies.” At Delaware & Lehigh National Heritage Corridor, 2022 truly did feel as if it “flew” by. Did people feel this rushed a century ago, or did life seem slower?

Thoughts like this are common amongst our team, popping up sometimes in conversation. They were particularly common during our monthly staff outings throughout the Corridor. Last year, we traveled to Jim Thorpe to view railroad and canal remnants. We visited Walnutport to explore the Locktender’s House. We toured Canal Works and the Grundy Museum in Bristol. It is important for us to get out, learn, and experience our five-county Corridor; to get to know our partners and the communities we work within.

In between growing new institutional knowledge and solidifying partnerships, 2022 provided exciting progress. We worked on expanding the stories we tell through the National Canal Museum. We cut ribbon for new D&L Trail miles and celebrated a \$7M funding commitment. Then, in the waning days of the 117th Congress, the National Heritage Area Act of 2022 passed with wide-scale bipartisan support, an achievement years in the making.

For us and many NHAs, this means 15 years of reauthorization and a codified relationship with the National Park Service. Both actions allow us to look farther into the future to inspire connections in our communities and celebrate the nationally significant history of our region.

As you flip through this report, we hope our efforts last year inspire you to travel the Delaware & Lehigh National Heritage Corridor with us in 2023, our 35th year.

## INDUSTRIAL HERITAGE Diversifying Stories

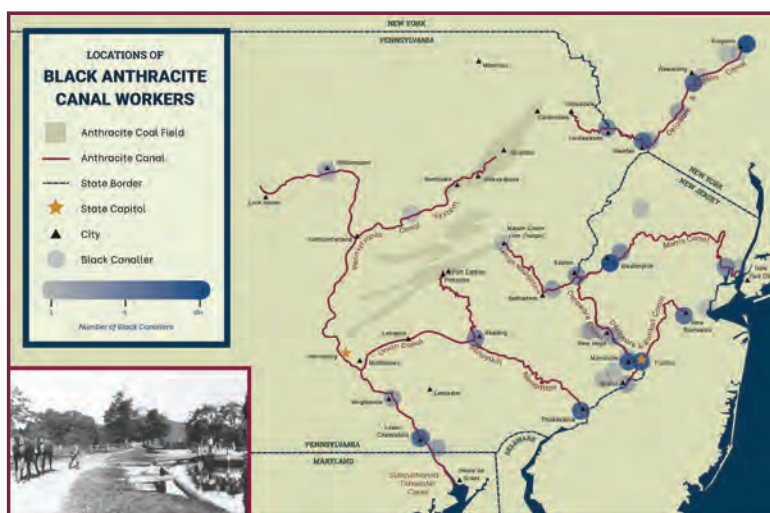
To engage new and old audiences, it has become increasingly important to share more inclusive narratives of our region's history. However, that's easier said than done. When aspects of history are not well-documented, we must go back to primary sources – census records, newspapers, and even oral histories – to illuminate the past and that takes time and effort.

**In 2022, we began a journey of discovery to reveal more diverse stories of people who made our five-county Corridor their homes and places of work. With the support of a grant from the National Endowment for the Humanities we focused our research on women who worked in the Corridor's industries and Black canal workers.**

One major outcome of the project was the museum's 2022 special exhibition, *Beyond Rosie and Rivets: Industrial Women of the D&L Corridor*. By incorporating artifacts, photographs, and audio clips of women discussing their work experiences, the exhibition celebrated the contributions of women to several of the region's industries including Bethlehem Steel, Dixie Cup, and Western Electric.

When we started to research Black canallers, we could count the number of known individuals on one hand. We have now documented over 170! Anyone can learn about these men and women using our online StoryMap that links together their names, locations, and any photographs or documentation. We're also using what we discovered to develop educational programs and resources that we can offer to schools and other groups in 2023 and beyond.

## 2022 was a year of revival for the Education Department.

We saw our numbers bounce back to pre-pandemic levels for both our school and community programs.

Our Kids on the Canal program celebrated its second year. Families were welcomed into the museum with monthly child-friendly, low-tech activities.

The Museum Experience continued to build upon itself in 2022. Schools and other youth organizations visited the museum and took a ride on our canal boat. While this program is available year-round, most of the visitors we saw came from summer camps and daycares that took summer field trips.

Immersion Days came back this year! For the first time since 2019, we hosted four weeks of Immersion Days field trips at the National Canal Museum in the spring.

## Throughout May, 1,655 kids from 19 schools in 12 districts visited.

During their visit, they learned about the history and construction of canals from 15 informative and engaging educators.

Our Freemansburg field trips also came back. As part of their curriculum, students in Bethlehem Area School District read *Tales of the Towpath*. They then spend the day at our satellite location in Freemansburg immersed in the setting of the book. Students were able to take part in engaging, hands-on living history experiences that brought the book to life.

DLNHC remains an important contributor to the education of the Corridor's children. We will continue improving our programs for both schools and the community.

Starting in East Penn Township Riverview Park, participants made their way through the Lehigh Gap towards Slatington. They then ran or walked along the canal towpath in Walnutport to journey back towards the finish line.

One race, three counties, and multiple landowners—the Heritage Half truly was an experience along the D&L Trail like no other.

Despite the rain that continued through most of the morning, the energy brought by our runners and walkers, spectators and volunteers was unmatched. New and returning participants alike cheered for one another as they reached the finish.

Of the race, DLNHC Executive Director Claire Sadler may have put it best:

***“Each year, I am energized by the stories we hear from participants and the enthusiasm they bring. This year, the weather was not what we ordered but so many participants smiled through the rain to help our mission of making connections within communities along and around the D&L Trail.”***

## NATURE & THE ENVIRONMENT Cultivating Connections

The Lehigh Valley is the third largest metropolitan area in the state, boasting diverse cultures and natural resources in a region rich in history. As a result, projects that fuse community, conservation, and connection become vital. Take for instance two projects supported by the our Lehigh Valley Greenways Conservation Landscape 2022 Mini Grant Program:

### **Enjoy the Ride, LV! Coalition for Alternative Transportation (CAT)**

This project provides group bike rides from April through October on local trails. The rides often incorporate skills practice and even clean-up activities.

### **Indigenous Medicine Wheel Garden City of Easton & PAZA, Tree of Life**

This year, the City of Easton partnered with PAZA, Tree of Life to install an Indigenous Medicine Wheel Garden at Hugh Moore Park.

PAZA is an inter-tribal support organization dedicated to the revival of Native American culture and wisdom, and inter-tribal healing and connection. Robert Christopher, Conservation Manager for the City of Easton, served as project manager for the mini grant. However, Robert also serves on the advisory board for PAZA, and was committed to building a project focused on what he calls the "three C's": community, culture, and conservation.

**Lehigh Valley Greenways is successfully cultivating connections within the community, to the benefit of the environment and everyone who calls this region home. We look forward to nurturing these connections in 2023.**

In November, we hosted a volunteer appreciation party to celebrate and recognize the contributions of volunteers to the organization. We even introduced our Mule Power volunteer shirts!

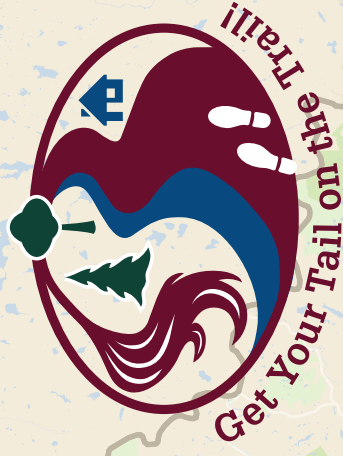

## Ashley Borough to Laurel Run North Corridor Analysis

At the end of 2022, the DLNHC and partners completed a planning study to identify potential future routes for 3 miles of D&L Trail from Ashley Borough's Main Street to Giant's Despair Park in Laurel Run Borough.

## White Haven Partial Opening

In Fall of 2022, Lehigh Gorge State Park re-opened more than 1.5 miles of improved D&L Trail heading north out of White Haven Borough, Luzerne County and connecting to Middleburg Road Crossing and north to Black Diamond Trailhead.

In September of 2022, the DLNHC supported Northampton and North Catsauqua Boroughs with the opening of their trail sections, completing the D&L Trail in Northampton County.



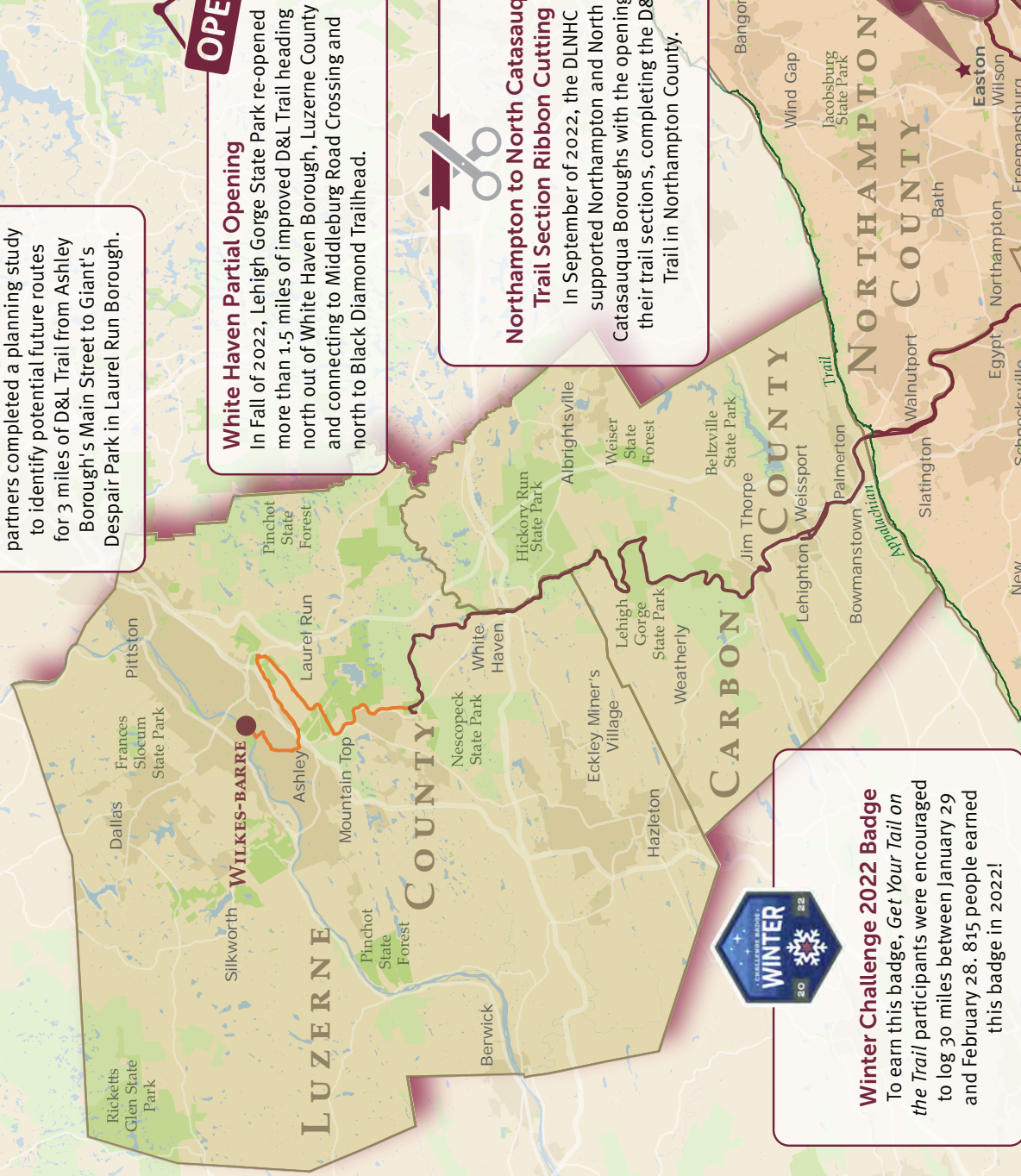
## DLNHC Headquarters in Easton, the National Canal Museum

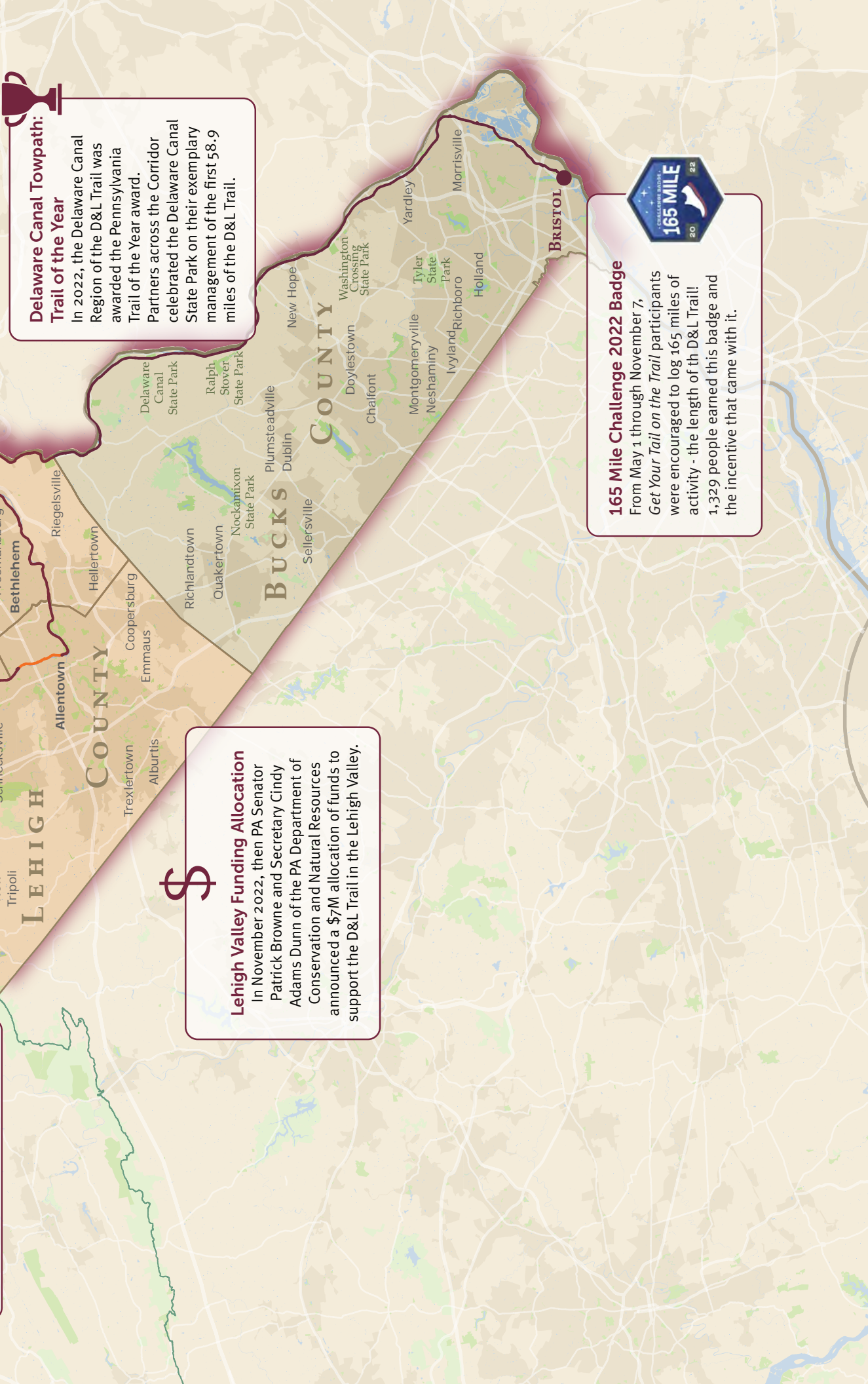


## Winter Challenge 2022 Badge

### Delaware Canal Towpath: Trail of the Year

In 2022, the Delaware Canal Region of the D&L Trail was awarded the Pennsylvania Trail of the Year award. Partners across the Corridor celebrated the Delaware Canal State Park on their exemplary management of the first 58.9 miles of the D&L Trail.

### 165 Mile Challenge 2022 Badge

From May 1 through November 7, *Get Your Tail on the Trail* participants were encouraged to log 165 miles of activity - the length of the D&L Trail! 1,329 people earned this badge and the incentive that came with it.

### Lehigh Valley Funding Allocation

In November 2022, then PA Senator Patrick Browne and Secretary Cindy Adams Dunn of the PA Department of Conservation and Natural Resources announced a \$7M allocation of funds to support the D&L Trail in the Lehigh Valley.

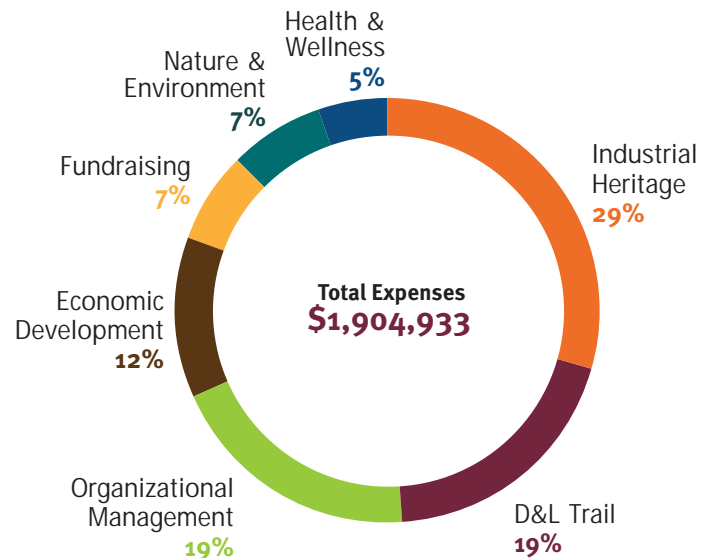
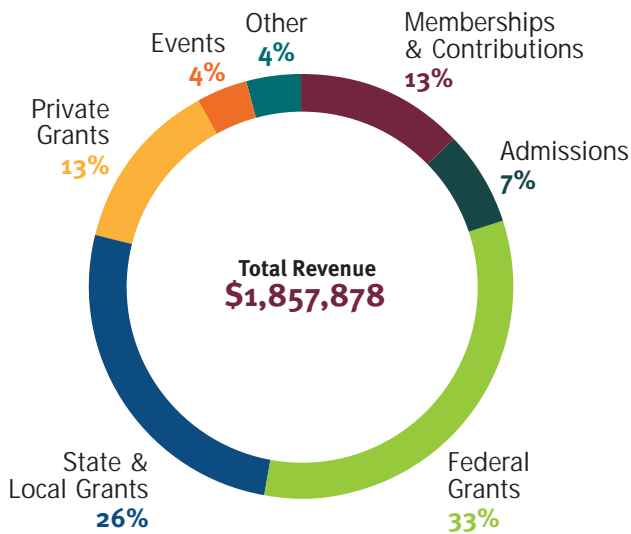
